General Rules on Payment of the User Fee Toll Fare

- One-way toll fares are collected from east- and west-bound traffic.
- Bridge Passes are available for class 1 only.
- Bridge Passes cannot be used when pulling a trailer (vehicles with trailers pay with cash or credit card).
- Bicycles are not charged for crossings. **Pedestrians are not permitted on the bridge.**

Information on Purchasing a Bridge Pass

Price for a Bridge Pass (lowest fare – save time and money (\$2.00 per crossing):

For Class 1 vehicles, the Bridge Pass requires the purchase of \$40 in pre-paid toll fares and a \$25 refundable deposit per tag. For more information, view the “Bridge Pass” category on the GIBC’s website grosseilebridge.com.
